**Nursery fees** are charged per term in advance. There are three terms per year. Nursery sessions are flexible. (Please see website for minimum session requirements.)

**Morning** sessions run from **9.00am – 12 noon**

**Full day** sessions run from **9.00am – 3.00pm**

**Wrap around care** during term time is available from **7.45am – 6.00pm**

**Holiday Club** is available out with term-time from **8.00am – 6.00pm**

In each area of school, apart from nursery, there will be no charge for after school care provided the pupil is collected within 15 minutes after the end of the normal school day. **The fee appropriate to each area is then applied hourly.**

## FEES: TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. The School operates a Direct Debit scheme for paying fees monthly. There is no additional charge for this service and details can be obtained from Mrs Jennifer Millar, St George's Edinburgh, Garscube Terrace, Edinburgh, EH12 6BG or email [JMM@stge.org.uk](mailto:JMM@stge.org.uk).
2. **A full term's notice must be given in writing to the Head if it is intended to withdraw a child, or a full term's fees will be due in lieu of notice.**
3. **A full term's notice must be given in writing to the Head if it is intended to change from boarding to day, otherwise a full term's boarding fee will be due in lieu of notice.**
4. If you do not make payment to school by the due date for payment of fees we may charge interest to you on the overdue amount at a rate of up to 3% per year above the base rate of the school's bank.
5. Fees are payable on or before the first day of each term.
6. Where three or more sisters are pupils at the same time, the third and subsequent sisters will receive a discount of one third of tuition fees. A discount scheme is also available with brothers at Merchiston. Please contact [JMM@stge.org.uk](mailto:JMM@stge.org.uk) if you need any further information on this. **Please note that the third child discount does not apply for Nursery.**
7. There is a requirement of 24 hours' notice for breakfast club and after school care (ASC) cancellation otherwise charges will apply.
8. Fees/charges are shown excluding VAT unless VAT has been explicitly included. If the VAT treatment of any fees or charges is changed, we reserve the right to charge VAT on top of the published fees.

Parents should also note that in addition to some fee assistance there are various Educational Trust Funds which can help in cases of need.
